### **Campus**

Our campus is one building, where we offer the convenience of a wide array of specialized care and services.

### **Clinic**

***HealthPartners Clinic – Hudson*** offers access to a wide range of specialty care and internal medicine on our health campus.

### **Emergency Room**

A 24/7 Emergency Center, staffed with board-certified emergency medicine physicians, that is equipped to handle a wide range of emergency medical needs.

### **Healing Arts program**

An innovative and nationally recognized program in partnership with the community that includes gardens, places of respite and original artwork with the goal of supporting a health environment.

### **Hospital**

A Unit where patients stay for general medical and surgical care for diagnosis and treatment of a medical condition.

### **Hudson Physicians Clinic**

An independent clinic providing primary care services on the health campus.

### **Health Care Directives**
